Through the medium of this letter, I would like to briefly highlight XXXX's interest, motivation and rationale behind participating in the UMA mechanism, both from an institutional and societal perspective. I will also lay down the objectives and goalposts that XXXX aims to achieve and the course of action that will be taken to achieve them.

The short to medium term objectives of XXXX are-

- 1. Establishing engagement with government agencies and local bodies
- 2. Networking with regional institutions
- 3. Initiating and fostering research practice according to regional needs, sensitivities and demands
- 4. Encouraging interdisciplinary teams for project work that include social science practitioners as well as science and engineering researchers

To achieve the above objectives, our agenda is as follows-

- 1. Set up a meeting with the collector of our district
- 2. Set up a meeting with other UMA empaneled institutions in the region
- 3. Identify 2 or more developmental areas for research per department and gradually build a file of case-studies in each area
- 4. Create academic space for inter-disciplinary regional field projects that can be undertaken by students (similar to TDSL course offered at IIT-B)
- 5. Start the groundwork (identify funding, compile existing case-studies, pass guidelines) for the establishment of an inter-disciplinary T&DC
